Update From The Eagle's Nest

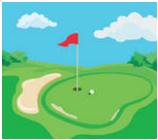
As the summer months come to an end, the Eagle's Nest will be switching our gears as we enter fall.

On The Course.....with Mark Harris

As September approaches we are hoping for cooler temperatures. August has been a very hectic month for us. The heat and heat indexes have really tested us and our greens. Each day we are using our water management skills to keep them alive while continuously watching out for diseases which may pop up. Many other clubs with bent grass greens throughout the southeast have also struggled with this heat stress. Fungicides and weekly fertilizations are being applied on a strict schedule.

Our actual soil temperatures have reached the mid 80's and have caused a shortening of the root zone. This puts a tremendous impact on the roots and affects the Grass' ability to accept nutrients back into the plant recovery. A break in the weather trend would be a blessing for the greens. I do appreciate the patience that everyone has had and we will overcome mother nature as soon as possible. Thank you for your patience as we deal with this heat.
